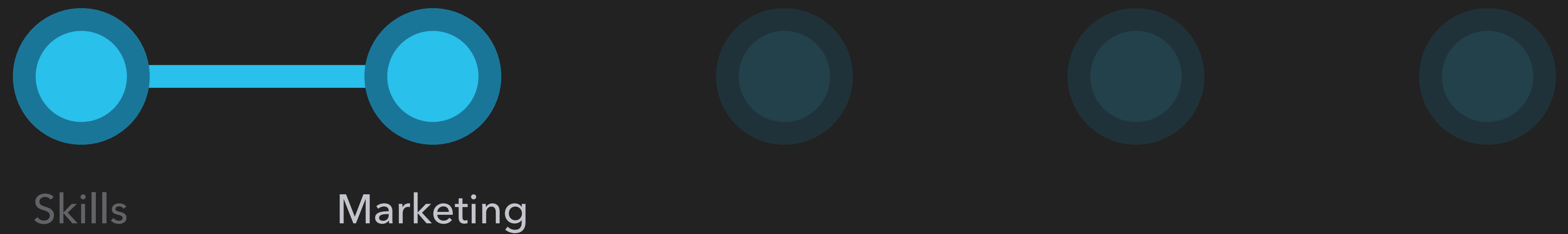

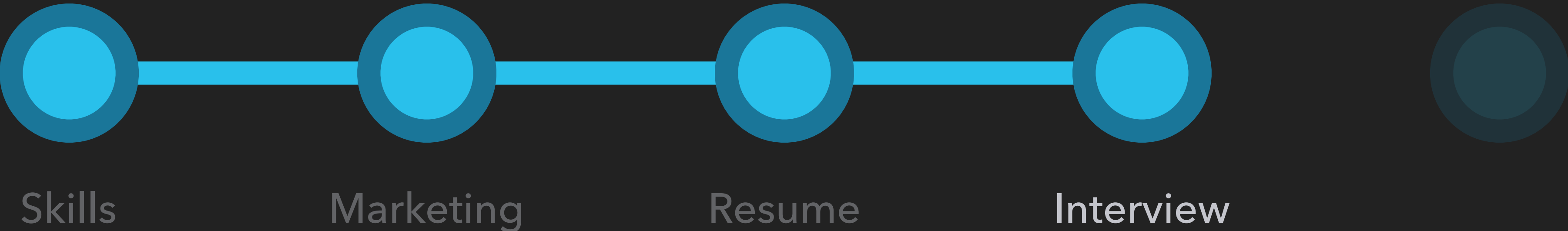

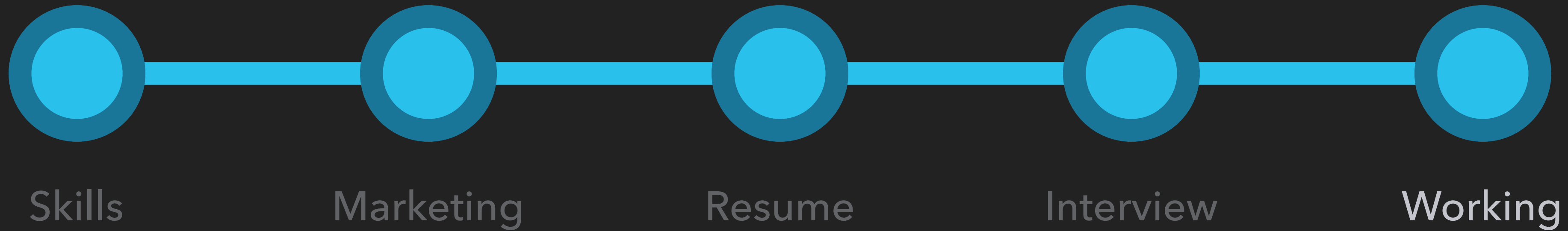

## WHY AM I EVEN DOING THIS?!

- ▶ Your resume is NOT an assignment
- ▶ It is a tool used to market you
- ▶ Similar to how a business card tells someone how to contact you, your resume tells another person what skills you have experience with.
- ▶ You need to paint a picture about how you will make your employer money!

## WHAT TO INCLUDE... FORMAT

- ▶ You should have **two different versions** of your resume:
  - ▶ **Text** only for email
  - ▶ **PDF or HTML** for printing

Tech experience should have more lines. Actual practical applications like school projects are great opportunities to highlight skills and technologies

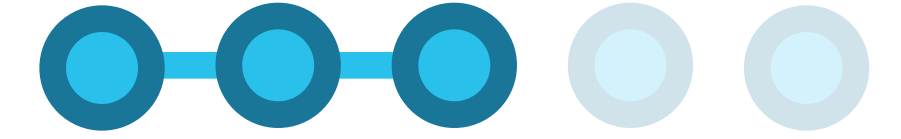

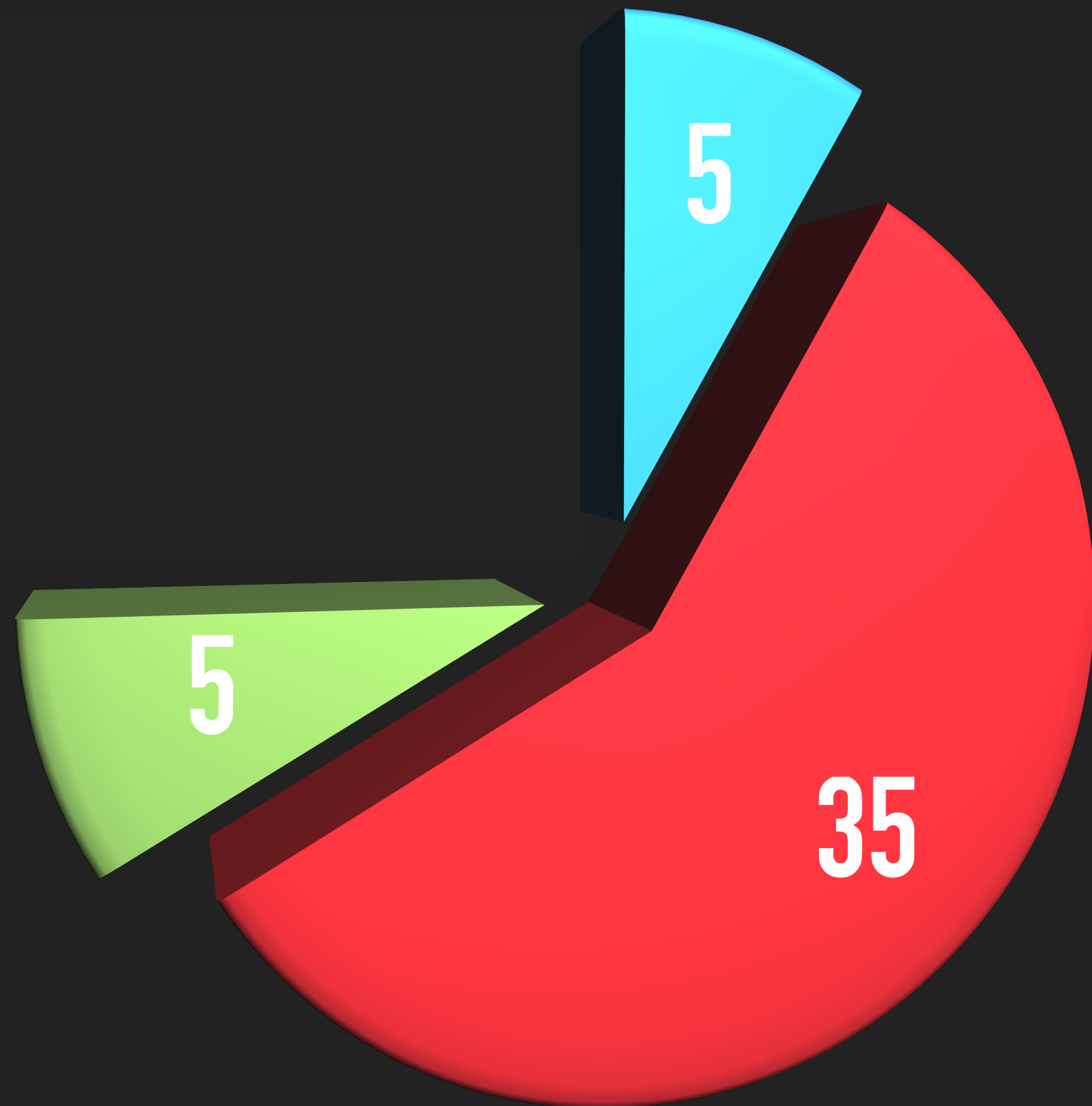


## TECHNICAL INTERVIEWS

- ▶ Technically strong
- ▶ Has the skills and interest
- ▶ Good Coworker
- ▶ AKA: Do I want to work with you?!



## TECHNICAL INTERVIEWS



### 5 Mins: Tell Us About Yourself

- ▶ This is for you to relax
- ▶ You know you, be your own cheerleader

### 35 Mins: Technical Question

- ▶ We'll get to this... next

### 5 Mins: Ask Us Questions

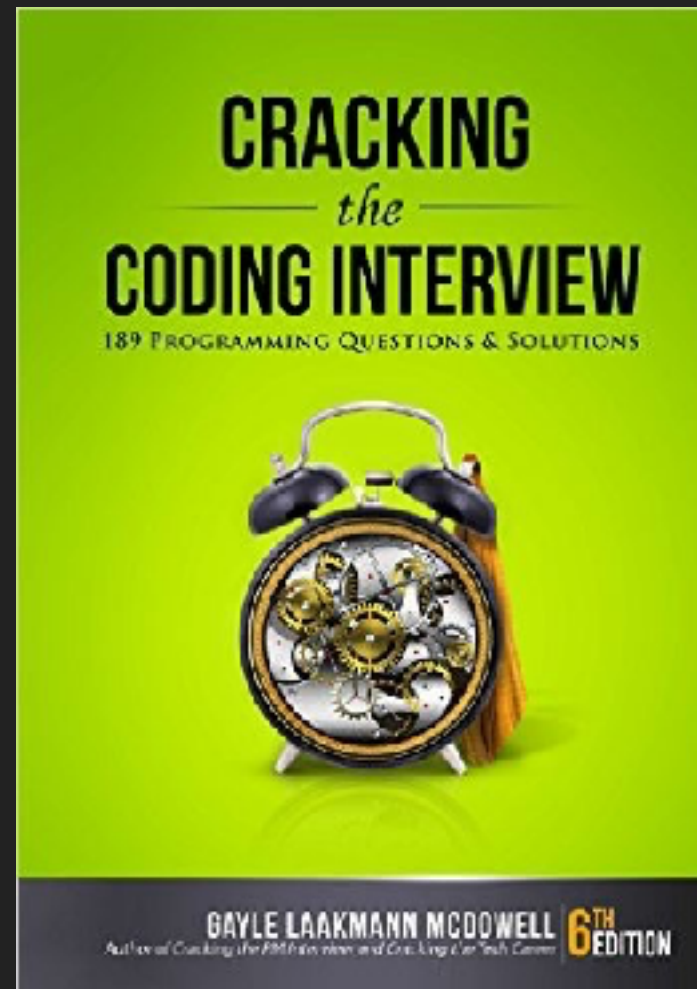
- ▶ You should always ask a question!
- ▶ Tip: Ask what an average day is like!



## HAVE THESE ANSWERS READY...

- ▶ What's your strongest programming language?
- ▶ What technologies are you interested in?
- ▶ Tell me a little bit about yourself?
- ▶ Why do you want to work here?
  
- ▶ Tip: Interviewers hardly look at your resume... **be quick to summarize it for them.**
- ▶ Tip: Back to back interviewers will often repeat questions... **just smile and repeat!**

## IDEAL QUESTIONS HAVE LEVELS...

- ▶ A naive answer - Co-op level
- ▶ A common answer - Standard level
- ▶ An expert answer - Experts/Senior level

## IDEAL QUESTIONS HAVE VARIANTS...

- ▶ Do it on a device with tiny memory
- ▶ Do it on a device with slow processor
- ▶ Do it with a poor network connection



## WHILE CODING...

- ▶ Plan your attack before coding
  - ▶ Identify problem
  - ▶ Identify data structures needed
  - ▶ Identify error cases!
- ▶ Ask questions early and often
- ▶ Write functions for areas that aren't on the top of your head  
(ie. `searchString(x, forY)` // Implement later)
- ▶ Always look at the complexity of your algorithm
- ▶ When in doubt... **USE A HASHMAP! O(1) FTW**
